BERLIN

- **The Brandenburg Gate** – is an 18th-century neoclassical monument in Berlin, built on the orders of Prussian king Frederick William II after restoring the Orangist power by suppressing the Dutch popular unrest. More than just Berlin's only surviving historical city gate, this site came to symbolise Berlin's Cold War division in East and West. With the fall of the Wall in 1989, the Brandenburg Gate became a symbol of reunification. Reconstruction started in the 1990s after German reunification and the buildings now include elegant town houses, embassies and the impressive five-star Hotel Adlon.
- **Berlin Wall** – came to symbolize the Cold War's division of East from West Germany nearly thirty years, from 13 August 1961 and in 1989, the Berlin Wall, which had stood for nearly 30 years, collapsed, and a year later, Germany was unified. In 1990, 118 artists from 21 countries painted on this section of East Side Gallery, the longest open-air gallery. The most famous is undoubtedly the work known as the "Fraternal Kiss".

DRESDEN

- **Dresden** – the third largest city in eastern Germany, a long history as the capital and royal residence for the Electors and Kings of Saxony. Known as "The Florence on the Elbe" due to its many gorgeous architectonic monuments and its location along the Elbe river.
- **Brühl's Terrace** – also known as the "Balcony of Europe". The Terrace is stands 500-metre long, an ancient old city ramparts were built in 16th century. Now, is a popular viewing platform in the old town of Dresden above the Elbe.
- **Procession of Princes** – The Procession of Princes, is a large magnificent mural of a mounted procession of the rulers of Saxony. The 101 meters consist of 27,000 porcelain tiles to make it weatherproof. This portrait depicts the entire history of Dresden through the men who built, controlled, governed and sparked new thoughts and ideas within it. It features Dukes, Electors, Kings and other leading figures from the arts and sciences.

NUREMBERG

- **Nuremberg** – known for its stunning medieval architecture. Nuremberg also famous for its Christmas market, which draws well over a million shoppers each year.
- **Schöner Brunnen Fountain** – The fountain was crafted in 1385-1396 and was the work of architect and stonemason Heinrich Beheim. The fountain is approximately 19 meters high and has the shape of a Gothic spire. The 40 colorful figures that adorn the fountain represent the world view of the Holy Roman Empire. The two brass rings embedded in the fence surrounding the fountain on opposite sides are said to bring good luck to those who spin them.

ROTHENBURG OB DER TAUBER

- **Rothenburg ob der Tauber** – German for "Red castle above the Tauber" due to town is located on a plateau overlooking the Tauber River. Rothenburg is famous for its well-preserved medieval old town, also known as the "treasure of the Middle Ages"
- **Town Wall** – The town walls were built to protect Rothenburg from its enemies. In spite of being very old, the walls are perfectly intact. The old quarter is surrounded by a town wall. The Walls give a view of 42 gate houses and towers in town. Six gates and several doors for pedestrians lead through this city wall into the old quarter (or out of it). Visitors can explore the city wall on Rothenburg's Tower Trail, which leads around the old quarter for four kilometers in about 2.5 hours.

- **Ratstrinkstube Clock Tower** – or Councilor's Tavern. The building's clock tower chimes every hour on the hour between 10 a.m. and 10 p.m., two doors open, out of one door comes a man in cavalier dress representing Count Tilly, and out of the other door a sober man dressed in black representing the Mayor Nusch, on either side of the clock face to reenact the legendary story of the brave mayor who drank nearly a gallon of wine in order to save his city. The famous "Legend of the Master Draught" is said to have occurred in 1631, during the Thirty Years' War. Every year hundreds of citizens dress up and celebrate the Master Draught.
- **St. James Church** – also known as St. Jacobs. Built in 1373-1436. It has two bell towers, the south tower is about 55.2 meters high, and the north tower is 57.7 meters high. Highlights of a visit to this historic landmark are the Altar of the Holy Blood, a superb wood carving depicting the Last Supper and etc.

REGENSBURG

- **Old Stone Bridge** – The 12th-century Stone Bridge, a 310m-long icon with 16 arches, crosses the river to the old town. The historic hub of Regensburg is Old Town, which separates it from Stadtamhof, but now incorporated into Regensburg, just across from the Old Stone Bridge.
- **Schloss St. Emmeram, Thurn und Taxis** – also known as St. Emmeram's Palace, the Palace was given to the family of Franz Von Taxis in the 16th century as recognition of his services of setting up the first European postal system. The Thurn and Taxis converted the monastery into a fancy schloss, with the 517-rooms, a romanesque-Gothic cloister, a neo-Renaissance marble staircase, a number of Rococo and neo-Rococo staterooms, and a Baroque library frescoed in 1737.

FÜSSEN

- **Neuschwanstein Castle** – is a 19th-century historicist palace on a rugged hill above the village of Hohenschwangau near Füssen in southwest Bavaria. The construction of the idyllic castle was started in 1869 on behalf of the shy and eccentric King Ludwig II, who had this castle built to escape public life. King, Ludwig II created his own dream world, a poetic world of the Middle Ages. Images were inspired by Wagner's operas and are about love and guilt and about repentance and redemption. The Schloss Neuschwanstein has more than 200 rooms, of which only 14 are fully finished. It served as the inspiration for Disneyland's Sleeping Beauty Castle and Cinderella Castle.

MUNICH

- **Frauenkirche** – or the Church of Our Dear Lady, is the biggest church in the city. The enormous Gothic-style Cathedral was completed in 1488, with the domes crowning its towers in 1525 at 99 metres in height, were finally covered with peculiar green domes.
- **Rathaus Glockenspiel** – it chimes and re-enacts two stories from the 16th century to the amusement. It consists of 43 bells and 32 life-sized figures. The top half of the Glockenspiel tells the story of the marriage of the local Duke Wilhelm V to Renata of Lorraine. Second story: Schäfflertanz (the cooper's dance).
