## ZÜRICH

- **Bahnhofstrasse** – Bahnhofstrasse is Zürich's main downtown street and one of the world's most expensive and exclusive shopping avenues. In 2011, a study named the Bahnhofstrasse the most expensive street for retail property in Europe, and the third most expensive worldwide. In 2016 ranked ninth.
- **Fraumünster Church** – The church was built from the middle of the 9th century on the opposite side of the river to the Grossmünster. Today, many visitors are attracted by the five stained glass windows prepared by Marc Chagall in the 1960's as well as by the rosette in the south transept.

## INTERLAKEN

- **Harder Kulm (Spring – Autumn)** – At 1322 m above sea level, the Harder Kulm – the nearest mountain to Interlaken – promises overwhelming views of Interlaken and the peaks of the Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau. The Harder Railway takes visitors from Interlaken to the two-lake footbridge at the Harder Kulm Panorama Restaurant in only 10 minutes.
- **Schilthorne (Winter Edition)** – By Gondola up to the Schilthorn at 2,970 metres above sea level. Marvel at the most spectacular panorama in the Alps : Eiger, Monch and Jungfrau - this is the Swiss Skyline.
- **Lucerne to Interlaken Express** – The panoramic journey between Lucerne and Interlaken could offers comfort and magnificent views through modern panoramic windows. En-route, you'll admire the breathtaking Alpine panorama, sparkling lakes and idyllic countryside.

## JUNGFRAU

- **Lauterbrunnen Valley** – one of the most popular destinations in Switzerland, boasting glacial waterfalls, hiking trails, ski slopes, dramatic cliffs, and quaint villages. This stunning destination is the gateway to the Jungfrau Region and it's often referred to as The Valley Of 72 Waterfalls.
- **Grindelwald** – Well known as the most beautiful fair-tale town in Switzerland and the famous mountain village is embedded in a unique Alpine landscape at the foot of the Eiger north face. It is the diversity of the glacier village that makes it so attractive. A wide range of activities and recreational opportunities amidst unspoiled nature is waiting to be discovered.
- **Jungfrauoch** – 4,158 metres is one of the main summits of the Bernese Alps, the top of Europe and the unique vantage point in the heart of Alps. Enjoy a spectacular panorama view over the Alps.
- **Ice Palace** – is carved within the Aletsch Glacier and is the highest-altitude ice palace in the world.

## GRUYÈRES

- **La Maison du Gruyère** – The show dairy, which was opened in 1969, is located in Pringy near Gruyères, at the foot of the castle hill. Here you get to know everything about the production of Le Gruyère AOP cheese, a process richly steeped in tradition that has been passed on from generation to generation. The farmers deliver their milk twice a day, and it is processed into cheese loaves by the cheese craftsmen. Naturally, one can watch them at work.

## GRUYÈRES

- **Gruyères Castle** – Perched atop a small hill with the mighty Swiss Alps in the background, the Gruyères Castle forms a picturesque fairytale-like image. Built-in the late 13th Century, the castle has been passed down through a number of noble families but has been remarkably well preserved throughout all these years. A Swiss heritage site today, it attracts a number of visitors every year due to its rich historical heritage and beautifully manicured hedge gardens. Today it is home to an art museum with paintings by notable artists like Jean-Baptiste-Camille Corot, Barthélemy Menn, and many others. A number of temporary exhibitions, cultural events, and music festivals are also regularly organized at its premises.

## MONTREUX

- **Chillon Castle** – An island castle located on Lake Geneva, south of Veytaux in the canton of Vaud. It is situated at the eastern end of the lake, on the narrow shore between Montreux and Villeneuve, which gives access to the Alpine valley of the Rhône. Chillon is amongst the most visited medieval castles in Switzerland and Europe. Successively occupied by the house of Savoy then by the Bernese from 1536 until 1798, it now belongs to the State of Vaud and is classified as a Swiss Cultural Property of National Significance. The Fort de Chillon, its modern counterpart, is hidden in the steep side of the mountain.

## LAUSSANNE

- **Olympic Park** – The Olympic Park in Lausanne is a city garden, established in 1993. It was opened along with a museum dedicated to the history of sport and the International Olympic Committee. In the Olympic Park, tourists can admire the large fountains and works of art related to the history of the Games. The dates of all matches with the names of players who lit the Olympic flame during the opening ceremony since 1936 were written on the stairs nearby. An eternal flame was placed directly in front of the entrance to the Olympic Museum.
- **Wine Tour** – The Lausanne wine regions reflect the diversity of the vineyards. The combined forces of glaciers, rivers, and mountains have produced diverse soil types and this enormous diversity is reflected in the great number of subtle nuances in the bouquets of the local wines. Lausanne has relatively high-altitude vineyards, often on steep slopes, offering an alpine terroir. Switzerland is a cool climate wine producer, and in winter it is not unusual to see snow around the vines.

## BERN

- **Bear Pit** – The Bern Bear Park is a unique recreation area at the lower end of the old town of Bern. It is open around the clock and free for all visitors. Brown bears have been living in this generously-sized enclosure on the banks of the river Aare since 2009.
