CASABLANCA

- Casablanca Literally means "white house" in Spanish, located on Morocco's Atlantic coast, is the largest city and principal port of Morocco. Serving as Morocco's chief port, it is one of the largest financial centers on the African continent.
- Hassan II Mosque situated partly on reclaimed land along the coast. It is the largest mosque in Africa, and the 3rd largest in the world. Its minaret is the world's second tallest minaret at 210 metres (689 ft). Completed in 1993, it was designed by Michel Pinseau and built by Bouygues. The minaret is 60 stories high topped by a laser, the light from which is directed towards Mecca.
- Old Medina of Casablanca Between the port and Hassan II's mosque there's the Old Medina, the oldest part of Casablanca which has the last remnants of the city of the twentieth century. The neighborhood is full of labyrinthine small streets and shops with handcrafted products.

RABAT

- Rabat is the capital city of Morocco. The medina and the modern city
 of Rabat listed as a shared World Heritage Site.
- Hassan Tower is the minaret of an incomplete mosque. According to the Sudan's construction of the largest mosque in the world, there was shortage of funds; the mosque sustained some damage in the Earthquake and the project was forced to be interrupted. Today, these remnants are considered to be an architectural art and It was granted World Heritage Status in 2012.

FES

- Fes or Fez is a city in northern inland Morocco and the capital of the Fas-Meknas administrative region. It is the second largest city in Morocco after Casablanca. The city largely consists of two old medina quarters, Fes el Bali and Fes Jdid, and modern urban area of Ville Nouvelle constructed during the French colonial era. In 1981, the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) proclaimed Medina of Fez a World Cultural Heritage site. The city has been called the "Mecca of the West".
- Fes el-Bali is the site of the famous Qarawiyyin University which was founded in 859 and the oldest continuously functioning university in the world. It also has Chouara Tannery from the 11th century, one of the oldest tanneries in the world.

ERFOUD

 Sahara Desert - is the largest desert in the world. Filling nearly all of northern Africa. The actual area varies as the desert expands and contracts over time. The area is next expected to become green in about 15,000 years (17,000 AD).

OUARZAZATE

- Atlas Film Studio Ouarzazate is a noted film-making location, is one of the largest movie studios in the world, land area built until 1983. Over the years, Ouarzazate has served as a shooting location for 'Gladiator', 'Alexander the Great', 'Spy Game' and many others, including 'Game of Thrones' were filmed here.
- Aït-Benhaddou Village One of the best preserved Kasbahs. The fortified village of Aït Benhaddou west of the city has been declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO. The picturesque of Aït Benhaddou lots of movies were shot there.

MARRAKECH

- Marrakech is the third largest city in Morocco, after Casablanca and Fez. The red walls of the city, have given the city nickname, the "Red City" or "Ochre City". The city is divided into two distinct parts: the "Medina" the historical city and the new European modern district called Gueliz. The Medina is full of intertwining narrow passageways and local shops full of character, listed as UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Jardin Majorelle Gardens is a two and half acre botanical garden and artist's landscape garden in Marrakech. It was created by the French Orientalist artist, Jacques Majorelle and later the property was sold to the fashion designers, Yves Saint-Laurent and Pierre Bergé. The villa houses the Islamic Art Museum, the Berber Museum and Yves Saint Laurent Museum. The gardens are a major tourist drawcard in Marrakech.
- Djemaa El-Fna Square The square is edged along one side by the Marrakesh souk, a traditional North African market catering both for the common daily needs of the locals, and for the tourist trade. As darkness falls, the square fills with dozens of food-stalls as the number of people on the square peaks. You can see Indian snake snakes, Arabs who sell spice tea, Moroccan old people who tell stories and fortune tellers, performers in various shows.
- Bahia Palace meaning brilliance in Arabic, is perhaps one of the best-preserved historical sites in Marrakech. It built between 1866 and 1867 by Si Moussa, and features 150 rooms.
