## TOURIST ATTRACTIONS:

### BANGKOK

- ◆ **Terminal 21 Shopping Mall** - Terminal 21 brings the dream of traveling the world to downtown Bangkok, with its cutting-edge concept that places several world-famous cities under one roof. Find yourself wandering around a maze of shops in Tokyo City, sauntering down London's Carnaby Street, bagging a bargain in an Istanbul zouk, or shopping for something to fill your growling stomach at the Fisherman's Wharf in San Francisco.
- ◆ **Four Face Buddha** - The official name is Erawan Shrine. It is a Hindu shrine in Bangkok. That houses a statue of Phara Phrom, the Thai representation of the Hindu creation god Brahma. A popular tourist attraction, it often features performances by resident Thai dance troupes, who are hired by worshipers in return for seeing their prayers at the shrine answered.
- ◆ **Ratchada Train Night Market** - The markets focus on antiques and vintage-style items, especially clothing and home accessories, as well as a large variety of food and drink. Its primary location at Si Nakharin has been ranked the most popular night market in Bangkok.
- ◆ **Maeklong Railway Market** - one of the Seven Wonders of Thailand. This is a unique market that is held every day literally on the rail tracks. Just before the train arrivals, the market stallholders have to pull back their awnings and remove their produce from the tracks. They then have to repeat all of this when train returns. (Remark: train arrival scheduled is subject to the change without prior notice)
- ◆ **Damneon Saduak Floating Market** - One of the most famous floating markets in Thailand. This buzzing market is routinely crowded with hundreds of vendors and purchasers floating in their small rowing boats sellings and buying or exchanging their goods. it's colourful, noisy, touristy but great fun.
- ◆ **Icon Siam Shopping Mall** - Has been called the 'Mother of All Malls' and it is set t open in 2018. With two towers, 80,000 square meters of land, a convention hall, a condominium and much more - it will be an enormous retail and dinning experience that will dominate several city blocks. It will contain an estimated 500 shops with 00 restaurants from more than 30 different countries.
- ◆ **Platinum Shopping Mall** - Which specializes in fashion clothes and accessories retail and wholesale.

### KANCANABURI

- ◆ **Wat Tham Sua (Tiger Cave)** - This pure Thai style temple is very recent (1971) and peched on a samll hill.. It has a huge Buddha covered with gold mosaics and a chedi that you can see from far away.
- ◆ **Jeath War Museum** - Is a war museum in Thailand about the Death Railway built from 1942 to 1943 by Allied POWs under the direction of the Japanese, a part of the Thai-Burma railways.
- ◆ **Visit Riverkwai (Death Railways)** - The world-famous bridge on the River Kwai, built during World War II by prisoners of war.
- ◆ **Giant Monkey Pod Tree** - A 20-meter-tall single rain tree, aged older than 100 year, features a shady canopy that is measured 51.75 meters in diameter, which means it crowns over an area of 2,416 square meters.
- ◆ **Mallika City** - Is the retro-city reflecting the past Siamese lifestyle in the Chao Phraya River Basin. During the reign of King Chulalongkorn, Rama V (1873-1910 A.D.), the people's way of life in 1905 A.D. was plentifully changed. The most pronounced was the abolition of slavery. When freed, these former Siamese slaves had to live and earn a living by themselves without control and supports from their noblemen and masters anymore. They had to live a life of self-sufficiency, self-reliant, and in harmony with all other Siamese people. These changing patterns of lifestyle are the cornerstone of today's Thai people.
- ◆ **Wat Ban Tham (Dragon Temple)** - The stairs leading to it ends in the jaws of a dragon before reaching the cave where the temple is.

### 观光景点:

#### 曼谷

- ◆ **Terminal 21 购物商场** - 是一座大型综合购物商场。整个商场以机场航站楼为概念，每一层则配以不同国家城市的特色，不光是售卖的产品有地域的区别，整个装修风格，包括卫生间都非常有意思。比如一层是巴黎，二层是东京，三层就是伦敦，上去就是美国圣弗朗西斯哥，所以每层的厕所也按照这个城市的风格设计的。
- ◆ **四面佛** - 在泰国被称有求必应佛，是曼谷著名的观光名胜。
- ◆ **火车夜市** - 市场专注于古董和复古风格的物品，特别是服装和家居饰品，以及各种食品和饮料。其在Si Nakharin 的主要位置被评为曼谷最受欢迎的夜市。
- ◆ **铁路市场** - 顾名思义就是一列火车会从市场中穿过，一天内总共要经过8列。在铁轨的两旁摆满了货摊，琳琅满目，货摊离铁轨也不过10厘米的距离，摊主悠然的在这里卖货，当火车警笛拉响时，所有的摊主会瞬间收起货摊，那速度可以用迅雷不及掩耳之势来形容，火车经过后，市场又立刻恢复了刚才的热闹繁忙景象。因为这一特色，火车市场吸引了来自世界各地的游客。
- ◆ **丹嫩沙多水上市场** - 最有名出镜率最高的水上市场，号称泰文化的“水上主题公园”，有超过100年的历史，但现在旅游商业化气息浓重。距市区约2小时车程，集市中，一条条船上，劳动妇女们戴着独特的草帽，坐在满载水果、蔬菜和鲜花的小船上，穿梭於狭窄的水道中，大声地吆喝叫卖，小河两岸有栉次鳞比的商店，出售各种特产和精美纪念品，还有一家家临水面而居的水乡居民住宅，构成了一幅令人深感亲切而又典型的曼谷印象画卷。
- ◆ **Icon Siam 购物商场** - 整个建案会包罗2个大型综合购物中心，占地达52万5千平方米，将是东南亚最大的购物中心!
- ◆ **水门市场** - 位于马努中心区，商店酒店不胜枚举，因此来这里首选的活动绝对是购物。

#### 北碧

- ◆ **虎穴寺** - 位于泰国中部北碧府的夜功水坝旁，是北碧最大坐、最出名的寺庙。由于寺庙内有一个山洞，发现时，洞口旁更有一对假老虎，因此寺庙名为虎穴寺。供奉一尊18米高的金色大佛，佛身由无数金色的马赛克磁砖拼贴而成，面朝向东方，右手施法印，左手平放在膝盖上，盘膝而坐，非常壮观。
- ◆ **北碧战争博物馆** - 他们在二战期间都一齐聚兵于北碧。博物馆看起来就像是战俘曾经居住过的小竹屋，里面有饭盒、钱、纸笔、信笺、地图等，全都是由幸存的战俘捐赠的。
- ◆ **桂河大桥 (死亡铁路)** - 折射了二战期间的一段历史：当年日军占领泰境期间，强迫盟军战俘建造铁路连接缅甸及暹罗，这条铁路在牺牲了无数宝贵生命后才得以完成，故有“死亡铁路”之称。桂河大桥就是其中的一段，被称为“死亡铁路”的咽喉。大桥的一边地势较为平缓，但一过河便是险峻的群峰，有的路段甚至就开凿在悬崖绝壁之上。
- ◆ **巨树雨** - 超过120年的树龄巨树，也是当地人祈福的圣地。
- ◆ **茉莉之城** - 带你穿越时空回到泰皇拉玛五世时期的古城裡走跳。
- ◆ **佛教寺庙** - 位于北碧桂河河畔，一间在山上的寺庙，寺内有一个天然山洞，洞内供奉有佛像。但 Wat Ban Tham 的造形独特，通往山洞之路是由一道长楼梯及一条龙组成，必需穿过龙身才可到达，故此又有人称为龙头洞寺。
